WRITING CONTEST: ENTRIES DUE TO CFWC BY FRIDAY, MARCH 1, 2024

(Contestants should contact their District's Contest Chair for the District Deadlines)

RULES FOR WRITING CONTEST:

- Authors must be dues-paying members of an active GFWC Club.
 - Exception: see Youth Categories below;
- Authors must be amateurs (earnings from writing may not exceed \$500 annually);
- Entries must be written between Jan. 1, 2023, and Dec. 31, 2023;
- Entries may not have been published prior to the competition and must be original works by the author.
- A signed GFWC Creative Arts Waiver must be included with each submission (additional forms required for youth entries).
- There are two categories:
 - Short stories are limited to 2,000 words.
 - o Poetry: entries can be any style, with a minimum length of eight lines, and a maximum of 50 lines.
- One entry per member per category.
- Entries must be:
 - Typed, double-spaced, printed on one side only.
 - Have minimum margins of one inch on all four sides.
 - o On 8.5" x 11" paper.
- Entries must have the following on the top right-hand corner of each page:
 - Author's name, email address, mailing address, and phone number.
 - o Club Name, District, Area, and State of the sponsoring club.
 - Category.
 - o Title of Work.
- See below for Youth Categories.

YOUTH CATEGORIES:

- While CFWC will not be judging this category at the state level, CFWC will submit District first place student writing entries to GFWC (international). Same Rules apply (as above).
- FOR MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18: A SIGNED MINOR'S CONSENT AND RELEASE FORM AND a
 MINOR'S PUBLICITY RELEASE FORM MUST BE INCLUDED WITH EACH ENTRY, in addition to the Creative
 Arts Waiver.
- For young students ranging from kindergarten to 12th grade. The four youth categories are:
 - o Category 1: Kindergarten, First, and Second Grade
 - o Category 2: Third, Fourth, and Fifth Grade
 - Category 3: Sixth, Seventh, and Eighth Grade
 - o Category 4: Ninth, Tenth, Eleventh, and Twelfth Grade
